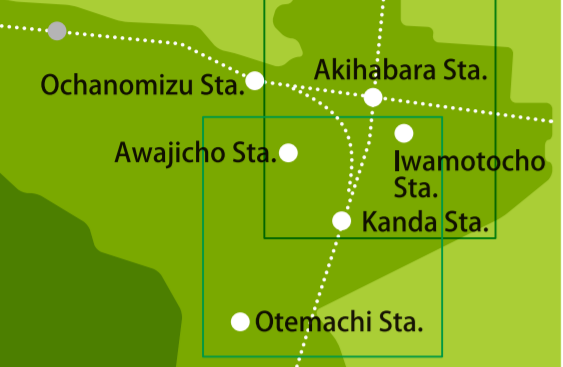


# The Accessibility Map of Chiyoda City

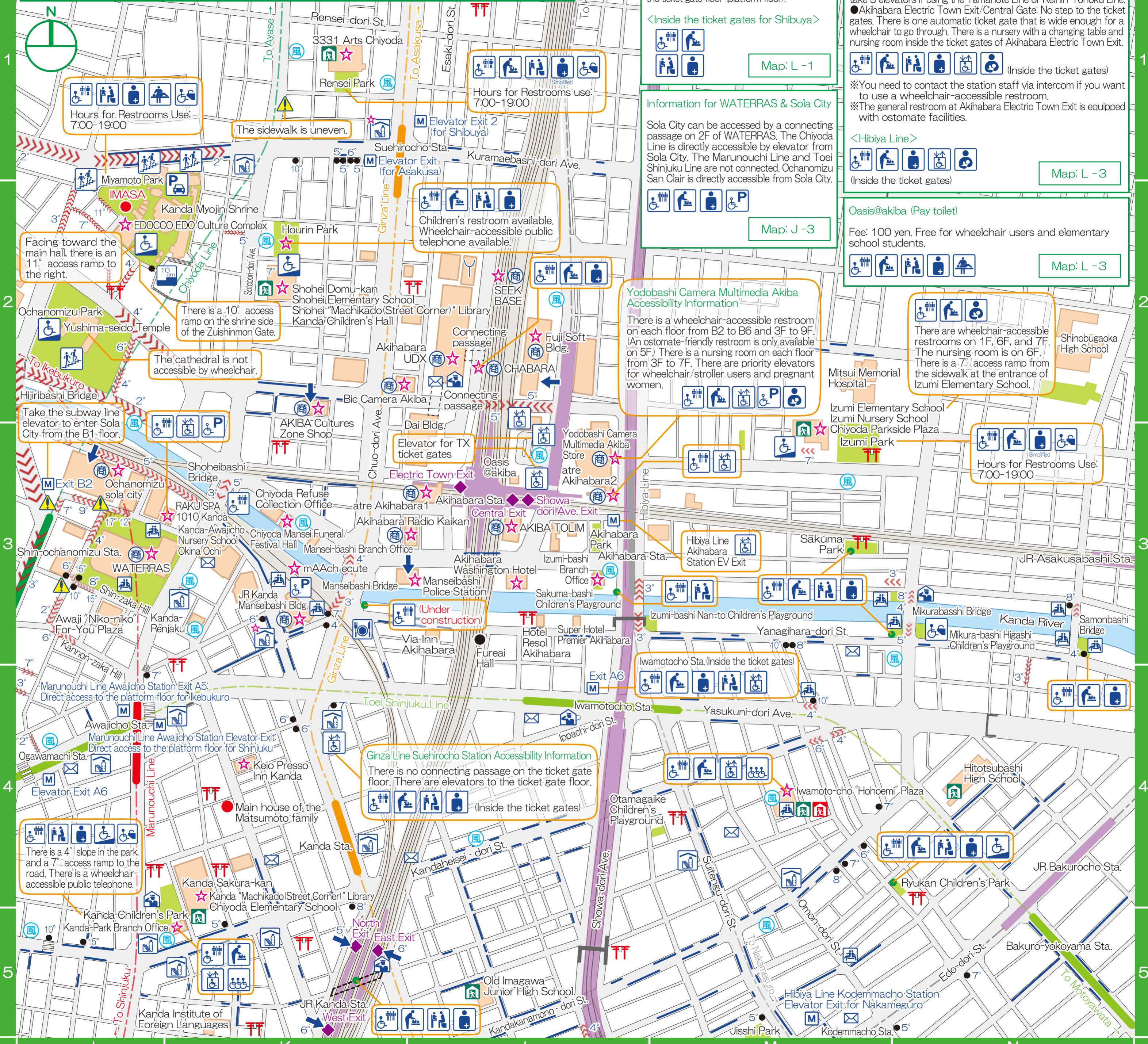

#### Suehirocho Station Accessibility Information

There is no connecting passage on the ticket gate floor. There are elevators to the ticket gate floor (platform floor).

#### Akihabara Station Accessibility Information

<JR> ● Showa-dori Exit: No step to the ticket gates. Access via the Central Gate is more convenient, because you have to take 3 elevators if using the Yamanote Line or Keihin-Tohoku Line. ● Akihabara Electric Town Exit/Central Gate: No step to the ticket gates. There is one automatic ticket gate that is wide enough for a wheelchair to go through. There is a nursery with a changing table and nursing room inside the ticket gates of Akihabara Electric Town Exit.

(Inside the ticket gates)

※ You need to contact the station staff via intercom if you want to use a wheelchair-accessible restroom.

※ The general restroom at Akihabara Electric Town Exit is equipped with ostomate facilities.

#### Information for WATERRAS & Sola City

Sola City can be accessed by a connecting passage on 2F of WATERRAS. The Chiyoda Line is directly accessible by elevator from Sola City. The Marunouchi Line and Toei Shinjuku Line are not connected. Ochanomizu San Clair is directly accessible from Sola City.

#### Oasis@akiba (Pay toilet)

Fee: 100 yen. Free for wheelchair users and elementary school students.

#### Yodobashi Camera Multimedia Akiba Accessibility Information

There is a wheelchair-accessible restroom on each floor from B2 to B6 and 3F to 9F. (An ostomate-friendly restroom is only available on 5F). There is a nursing room on each floor from 3F to 7F. There are priority elevators for wheelchair/stroller users and pregnant women.

#### Izumi Elementary School

There are wheelchair-accessible restrooms on 1F, 6F, and 7F. The nursing room is on 6F. There is a 7' access ramp from the sidewalk at the entrance of Izumi Elementary School.

#### Ginza Line Suehirocho Station Accessibility Information

There is no connecting passage on the ticket gate floor. There are elevators to the ticket gate floor.

(Inside the ticket gates)

There is a 4' slope in the park, and a 7' access ramp to the road. There is a wheelchair-accessible public telephone.

  - Restaurant ※There is a flat floor or access ramp at the entrance/exit. There is a wheelchair-accessible restroom.
  - Rest area with places to sit down
  - AED installed (Only the city's public facilities are shown)
  - Slope of at least 5° (●)
  - Step of at least 5 cm (●cm)
  - Low High Slope (Inclined)
  - ※ The slope angle may differ depending on the position measured, so please regard this as a rough guide.
  - Facility, etc. entrance/exit
  - Entrance/exit with an elevator, stairlift, etc. connecting the ground floor and the platform floor
  - Marunouchi Shuttle Bus stop
  - Welfare shuttle bus "Kazaguruma" bus stop
  - Tourist attraction
  - Shrine
  - Places that require caution when going around the town
  - Police station / police box
  - Post office
  - District shelter
  - Welfare shelter
